# The Young Guns Participate in SCTP Nationals in Ohio!

The Arrowhead Young Guns Scholastic Clay Target Program team traveled to Marengo, Ohio in July to compete in the 2024 SCTP National Championship. This was the third consecutive year our team has traveled and competed in the National event. Arrowhead Gun Club and Virginia were well represented as nine of our Arrowhead Young Gun athletes shot American Skeet, American Trap, Sporting Clays and Make-A-Break disciplines. Once again, our athletes proved their addiction to burning gun powder by breaking 4,634 clay targets out of 5,200 clay targets thrown. The 89.1 break percentage earned our team 15th place out of 115 teams from across the United States. The 2024 SCTP National Championship was the largest in SCTP history with over 4,000 youth athletes competing in shotgun sports.
